

Xylazine Test Strip Now Available

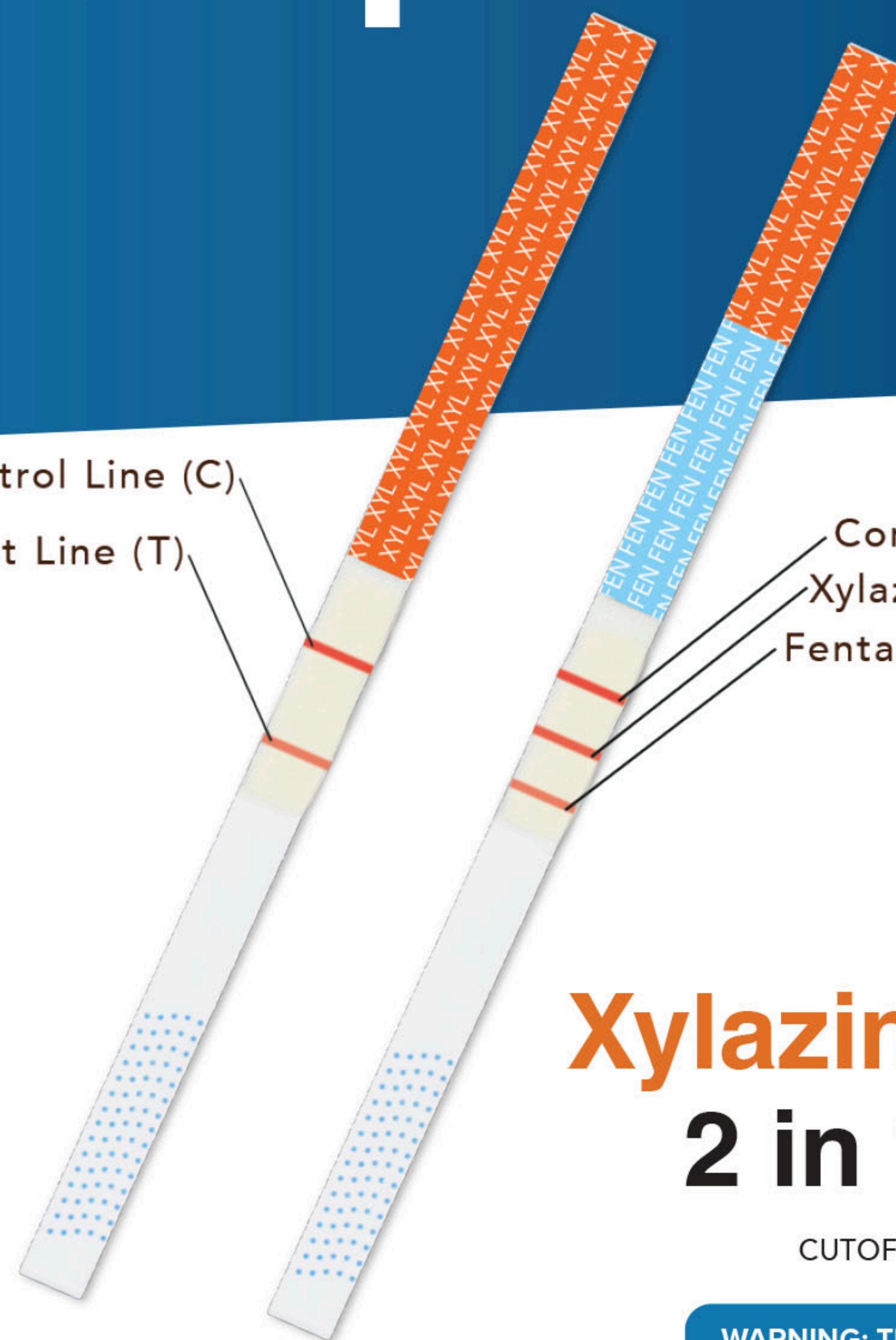

Xylazine, a non-opioid veterinary tranquilizer not approved for human use, has been linked to an increasing number of overdose deaths nationwide in the evolving drug addiction and overdose crisis. Research has shown xylazine is often added to illicit opioids, including fentanyl, and people report using xylazine-containing fentanyl to lengthen its euphoric effects. As xylazine is not an opioid, naloxone (Narcan) does not reverse its effects.

Consequently, xylazine and fentanyl drug mixtures place users at a higher risk of suffering a fatal drug poisoning. People who inject drug mixtures containing xylazine also can develop severe wounds, including necrosis that may lead to amputation.

Xylazine Test Line (T)



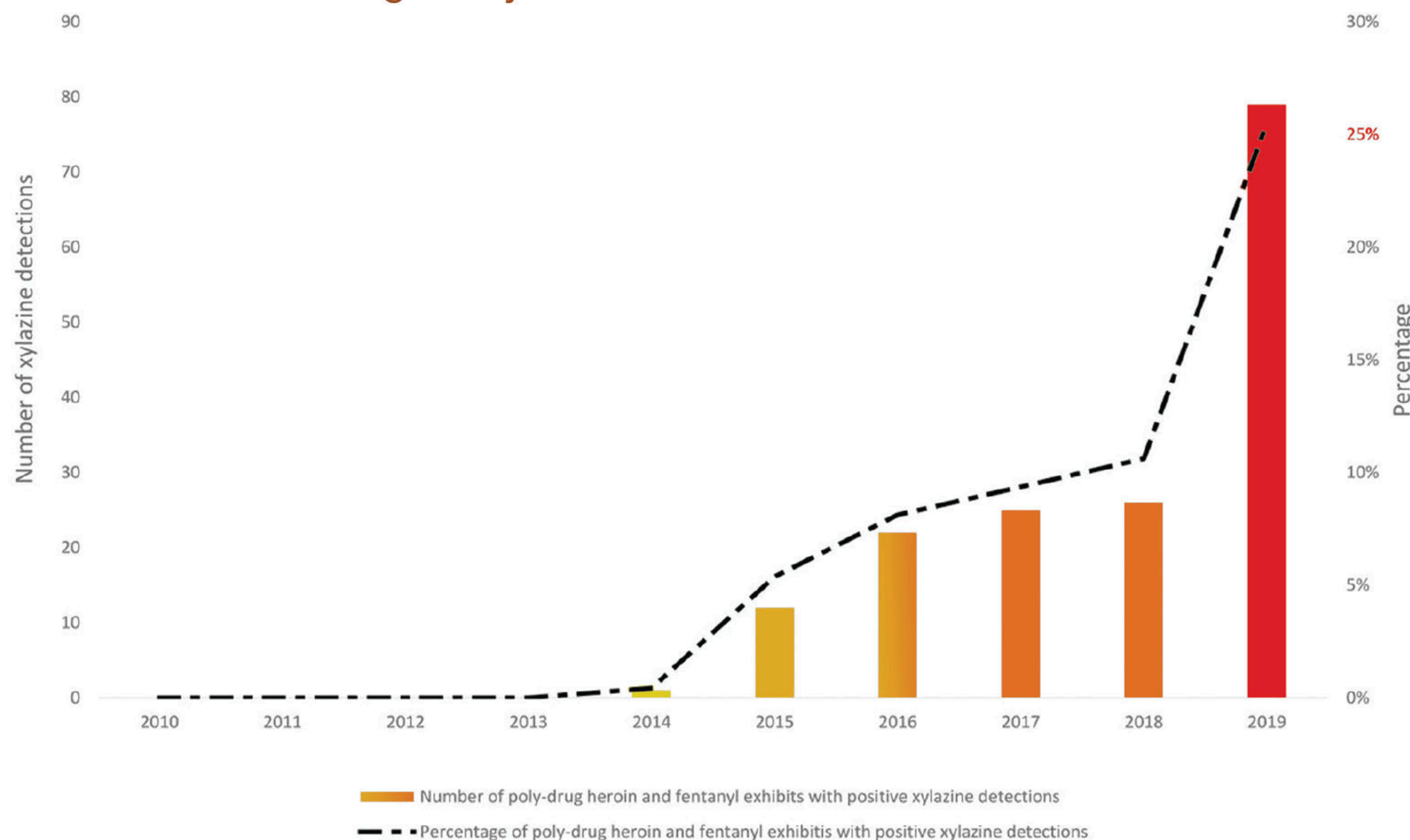

National Increase in Xylazine Seizures

Number and Percentage of Xylazine Detections*



Drug seizure data tested in **Drug Enforcement Administration** laboratories indicates that **xylazine** is **increasing in polydrug samples** in which the primary drug detected is heroin or fentanyl. While no polydrug seizures contained xylazine between 2010 and 2013, 5% contained xylazine in 2015, 9% in 2017 and **25% in 2019**
